NEW MISSION IN CHINGELTEI

Several years ago a group of about 12 people broke away from a group called, "Christ's Church" here in UB. This church had it's roots in the Church of England. 3 years ago they came to Brother Dennis and asked him to come and teach them.



This lasted just a short time before they said they believed they could go it alone. Then 6 months ago the leaders of this group came to Brother Dennis and Brother Egi once again and expressed how they understood that something was missing and that they were not

doing things according to God's Word. So once again they asked Brother Dennis to come and teach. This time they wanted to know what makes up a real church of God. Since then every Sunday afternoon Dennis and Egi have traveled to Chingaltai and brought a series of lessons about what makes up a Scriptural New Testament Church. The second week of August, they spoke as a group to Dennis saying that they now understand what is needed to do things God's way and they are ready to do just that. They gave good testimonies of salvation. On the last Sunday of August three came asking to unite with Rich Heart Baptist Church by baptism. They were all baptized that same day. Others have been attending the Bible studies. Some need baptism and some need salvation.

The RHBC had already voted to send Brother Dennis Carrell to teach in Chingaltai about the church. This month they voted to send him as their missionary to begin a new mission work in Chingaltai with these new members. Chingaltai is in one of the many ger (tent) districts surrounding Ulaanbaatar. It is an impoverished area where most people are in survival mode. Their day is concentrated on how to survive that day. A very few have running water, or an indoor sewer system. It is about a 30-45 minute drive from our building. Brother Dennis will not move to that area, but will remain here running the NGO and directing the Translation team. Pray for this work as the Lord establishes a church there.

GOD PROVIDES EVERY NEED



With Dennis working with a new mission another translator became a great need. God had already been working on that need before we ever knew about it. One of the translators that we had hired for the Bible translation was Sainhuu. (In Mongolian it means "good son")

Sainhuu already had a good testimony of salvation when he was hired, but was not attending any church at that time. During team translation and Bible studies with him after work, God convicted him of his need to serve in a New Testament Church. At the same time that the Chingeltai group came for baptism so did Sainhuu. He has also dedicated himself to be Dennis' tongue in Chingeltai. He has also expressed his desire to become a pastor to the Mongolian people. Keep this young man in prayer

PROPERTY BOUGHT IN CHOIR

The first week in August two parcels were purchased in the village of Choir. The property is 50m x 80m (164' x 263') and was purchased for 1,600,000 tugrugs or about \$1391. Two gers have been purchased and erected. One for services, and one for Brother Agi, and his wife Olzii to live in. The RHBC traveled to Choir and in one day fenced in the entire property. (For a full story and pictures go to our webpage and click on "what's happening") On the third Sunday in August they met for the first time on their own property and in their own ger. Plans are being drawn for a building and a place for the missionary to live. The last week of August, Agi and Olzii, moved to Choir to begin working full time on the field. Anywhere in Mongolia can be difficult to live, but moving from UB to Choir is as difficult for a Mongolian as it is for an American moving from the USA to Mongolia. Agi and Olzii are leaving two daughters here so they can finish school. One daughter is 21 and in college the other is 17 and has one year of high school left.

A BREAK AND RETREAT FOR THE MISSIONARIES

For the first time since Dennis and Charlotte came to Mongolia in 1999 they are taking an actual vacation. The Carrell's and Cooper's, will travel to Corfu, Greece for the Missionary Retreat hosted by the Rayburn's. This past year has seen many changes and challenges to the work in Mongolia and a time of refreshing is needed by all. We would like to thank all who helped in making this trip possible.
