Another very hot month in the state of Ohio. We had temps in the 90's most of the month. We have had a lot of sickness during the month and some are still recovering. Our attendance was down some due to sickness and vacations. Only three weeks left and our kids are back in school. The parents are looking forward to it and the kids say they're not ready.

We averaged 45 for the month of July with several first time visitors. The gospel was shared with some this month and we are praying for God to convict them for salvation, baptism and service. Our people continue to learn about Jesus and the things He wants from them. Our mobile chapel has been a real blessing to us and it shows the community we are here for the long haul.

Mom's house has sold and escrow is to close around August 20th. We hope to start building as soon as we can. We want to still do this debt free. When the Lord called me to Ohio, Kathie and I had watched several of our mission points struggle and go so far in debt they never seem to recover. We said as long as God would supply we would wait on Him to open doors. We have spent well over \$100,000 on plans, land, septic system, water, and electrical hookup. We are still debt free. God has supplied as we have laid our prayer requests at His feet and waited for Him. We will have somewhere around \$65,000.00 from the sale of this house. We are praying that God's people will help us put our new building up. It would only take several churches to give to this fund. We will need another \$150,000 to \$175,000. That seems like a lot but God owns everything and is able to supply. We thank all that support this work with money and prayer. Help us finish up this work. We want to send missionaries out over the state of Ohio. Once again thank you for everything you have done to help us.
